

Driver's Education Online Course for Students Age 15 and Older

Step 1: Go to www.cal-driver-ed.com. Fill out personal info and create your own user name and password. Complete the course online. You MAY NOT drive yet.

Step 2: When you have completed the entire online course, give Mrs. Becker in Room 1 the username and password in writing and she will forward your information along with the Purchase Order number to Cal Driver Ed. You will receive 2.5 elective credits from KTL on your school transcript when you bring your certificate to be copied in Charter 1.

Step 3: Obtain a permit. Note: There are different rules for students between 15.5 years and 17.5 years than for students older than 17.5 years.



While you wait for your certificate, contact a driving school to make arrangements and make a permit test appointment at the nearest DMV office (www.dmv.ca.gov). When you receive the certificate in the mail from Cal Driver Ed, you will take the certificate and paperwork from the driving school to the DMV to take the permit test if you are 15.5 years or older. The permit is then signed at a local driving school when you take your first lesson.

The driving school is paid by the student and is required if you are under 17.5 years of age. Over 17.5 you may take the permit and drive with a responsible adult and then take the test at age 18. Driving school is optional over 17.5 years of age.

Step 4: Practice driving with your parent while you have a permit. After you pass your driving test, your license will be RESTRICTED for one year if you are under 18 year of age. This means that other students may NOT RIDE as your passengers unless a parent is present. Your parent must also fill out a driving permission form if you will be driving yourself to school. You are not permitted to leave campus for lunch.

Step 5: KTL also has a course from AAA called *Responsible Driving* for a student and parent to complete together. This is also worth 2.5 elective credits but does NOT satisfy the DMV permit requirement.
